


Gouda for tour operators









Welcome to Gouda, a real Holland Classic!

The town is world famous for its cheese market, cheese, syrup waffles, pipes and pottery. The compact and picturesque historic town centre with its many sights, authentic boutiques, small medieval streets, canals and courtyards is well worth a visit. All the sights are within walking distance of each other. Due to its central location Gouda is an ideal base for excursions in the region, for example, to Kinderdijk or the Keukenhof. That is why Gouda is a perfect travel destination and should be included in your tour selection, for day trips as well as multi-day trips.

More than cheese and syrup waffles

Gouda is one of the few towns with a freestanding late Gothic town hall. This beautiful historic building with red and white shutters stands in the middle of the Markt. And what about the longest church in the Netherlands: the 123-metres long Sint-Janskerk with its 72 unique stained glass windows? Or Museum Gouda with the unique maquette of the town and special exhibitions? Water has played an important part in Gouda's rich history as well. A canal boat sightseeing tour is highly recommended. You can also experience the archaic atmosphere in the various crafts shops. Thanks to its bustling terraces and restaurants establishments, rich culture and history, Gouda is a delightful destination!

Gouda is centrally located

Gouda is in a central location in the west of the Netherlands close to the motorway. Gouda also has good train links. It is just a 30-minute ride by road or by rail to the cities of Rotterdam, The Hague, Delft, Utrecht and Leiden. Gouda is a medium-sized town with more than 75,000 inhabitants.





Nearby coach parking

Approximately 500 meters from the Markt there are 2 car parks with designated parking bays for coaches. The parking charges at P1 and P2 are a maximum of € 8 per day.

P1 + H1 | Klein Amerika (2806 CA)

In front of the entrance of the car park there is a coach drop-off point (H1). The car park has 5 coach parking bays. There are toilets at the Chocoladefabriek (entrance P Klein Amerika).

P2 Schouwburgplein (2806 AE)

At the back of the car park there are 4 coach parking bays. It is a 200-meter walk to the Gouda Cheese Experience.



Gouda Highlights

Discover the medieval town centre with its history that goes back centuries. Admire the beautiful facades, stroll along the picturesque canals and charming courtyards. Visit the many sights, sample some Gouda cheese and bite into a finger licking syrup waffle.



Sint-Janskerk (church) & Gouda Glass

When the sun shines through the 72 world famous stained glass windows it immediately becomes clear what makes the Sint-Janskerk in Gouda so special. It is the only church in the world where so much 16th-century stained glass has survived. The stained glass windows in Gouda are a highlight of the European art of glass painting. Be amazed by the stunning colours and the lively play of light that give this church a tranquil atmosphere. The Sint-Janskerk is an impressive 123 meters long, making it the longest church in the Netherlands. An audio tour included in the entrance fee brings its history to life.



The town hall

During the summer of 1438, a devastating fire reduced the then town of Gouda virtually to ashes. The town council decided that the new town hall should be freestanding. It chose a new location on the market field, which was little more than a sodden peat bog at the time. Visit the splendid wedding hall, the mayor's office and council chamber. On the right facing wall you can see the carillon with mechanical puppets, which were added in 1961. The leading figure in the carillon is Floris V, who granted Gouda its town charter in 1272. Every two minutes past the hour and two minutes past the half hour you are treated to a lovely spectacle.

Museum Gouda

From Ferdinand Bol to Isaac Israels, from the Gouda clay pipe to a 16th-century triptych: Museum Gouda has a unique collection. Discover 16th-century altar pieces, a huge interactive maquette of Gouda as it was in 1562, 17th-century militia group portraits and French and Dutch paintings from the 19th century. You can also enjoy the famous Gouda pottery, known as Gouds plateel. Besides the permanent collection there are always temporary exhibitions. Museum Gouda is located in the former Catharina Gasthuis, a beautiful monumental building right opposite the Sint-Janskerk in the oldest part of Gouda.

Reederij de IJsel

Reederij de IJsel offers canal boat sightseeing tours through the monumental town centre of Gouda. En route, the captain elaborates on historic points of interest with amusing anecdotes. Reederij de IJsel has typical Dutch Boats. These boats breath history, but at the same time they have all the facilities needed for a comfortable tour. There is a saloon, a toilet and a kitchen. These round trips are not wheelchair friendly.

Goudse Gidsen Gilde

A guided walking tour around the town is guaranteed to give you a unique introduction to the historic centre of Gouda and the town's glorious history. The most frequently booked walking tour is the historic town tour. The guild also offers many more themed walking tours, such as the courtvard tour, the water tour and the cheese tour. The Goudse Gidsen Gilde has more than 20 guides and offers walks in various languages.

De Goudse Waag | Cheese and Crafts Museum

This authentic building was designed in 1668 by architect Pieter Post. The ground floor of De Goudse Waag was formerly used to weigh cheese. Today, De Goudse Waag houses the Cheese and Crafts Museum. Discover everything about the history of cheese, find out how it is made and how cheese was traded and weighed here via an audio tour. There are also several cheese tasting sessions that are held in the cosy tasting room on the first floor. Gouda Tourist Information is located on the ground floor.

Gouda Cheese Market

Every Thursday morning from 10.00 to 12.30 hrs, during the period from April to August (except on King's Day and Ascension Day)

The Gouda Cheese Market is a spectacular historic and nostalgic scene. If you would like to visit the cheese market, make sure you are on time. As in past times, the farmers and traders seal their bargains for the best cheeses through clapping hands. Besides the worldrenowned cheese, you can also shop at the stalls filled with regional

Gouda by Candlelight

One of the oldest light festivals in the Netherlands. In the evening 1,500 candles light up the windows of the historic town hall and thousands more light up the windows of the buildings in the town centre. There are also all kinds of activities, such as a Winter Fair, walks, concerts, shows and performances in museums, churches, De Goudse Schouwburg and the streets. Highlight is the lighting of the Christmas tree between 19.00 and 20.00 hrs. Every year Gouda is presented with a Christmas tree by its Norwegian twin town Kongsberg.

Gouda Cheese

When people say cheese, they say Gouda! Gouda cheese is among the best-known, widely consumed cheeses in the world. The history of this famous cheese, which dates back to the 14th century, is still made in the traditional manner on cheese farms in villages near Gouda, such as Stolwijk, Haastrecht, Reeuwijk and Bergambacht. Syrup waffles

Everyone in the Netherlands is familiar with the syrup waffle and at one time or another has sunk their teeth into one of these biscuits from Gouda. Its original name is a syrup waffle. Invented for the poor who could not afford more expensive biscuits. The delicacy was first made at the beginning of the 19th century in Gouda. Discovered in 1810 among the oldest recipes, the syrup recipe called for the waffles to be baked from leftover dough and crumbs and filled with syrup.



Gouda candles

In 1853, three gentlemen from Gouda established a candle factory called the "Stearine Kaarsenfabriek". It quickly became a success and was incorporated on 24 February 1858. In 1899, the company received its Royal designation. This factory was the founder of the first, authentic Gouda Candles.



Gouda ceramics

There is a century-old, rich tradition in Gouda of making pipes, household and ornamental pottery. Museum Gouda has an in-house collection of more than 1,200 pieces of Gouda ceramics, the best examples of which are on display in the Catharina Hall. In the depot you can see the most diverse objects. You will see a number of well displayed, well-known dinner service sets. The extremely rare Art Deco vases will hold you spellbound.



Gouda, the beer city of Holland

In the Middle Ages Gouda had the reputation of being the best beer city in the Netherlands. Around 1470 Gouda was home to 200 brewers producing 15 million litres of beer each year. Today Gouda once more has several breweries that brew the finest Gouda beers.



Gouda clay pipes

A Gouda pipe is a clay tobacco pipe smoked by many men in the 18th century. In 1606, English mercenaries arrived in the Netherlands as reinforcements for Gouda. They taught the people of Gouda how to make the pipes. Later, in 1660, the Guild of Gouda Pipe Makers was founded.

Workshops & tastings

Include one of the many tasting sessions or workshops that Gouda has to offer in your package. Gouda wets your appetite! Taste the famous Gouda cheese in combination with a beer, a wine or maybe even a whiskey tasting session. Tasting sessions are offered by, among others, **De** Goudse Waag, Beer Café de Goudse Eend, Den Gouwen Aar oand Barbier. IJsselhuis Gouda even offers a cheese-wine-beer battle. What combines best with cheese, wine or beer? Make a delicious Gouda syrup waffle at Berg's Bakery. Sample and mould chocolate into the prettiest shapes at PUUR Proeverij or Olala Chocolade. Mix the tastiest cocktails at Dependance Gouda

Cheese farms

You can easily combine a visit to the centre of Gouda with a visit to one of the cheese farms in the Gouda region. All of them offer lunch options. Taste Gouda farmhouse cheese, take a tour of the farms and find out how cheese is made. It is 9 km to **Cheese farm Hoogerwaard**, a 17th-century farm that produces Gouda cheese. Family business **De Twee Hoeven** is in Haastrecht, which is 4 km away. And you can even drive your coach through the stable of **Dairy and cheese farm Schep**, home to as many as 600 dairy cows, which is 16 km away!

Get active in and around Gouda

Explore Gouda on foot, all the sights are within walking distance. The guides of the Goudse Gidsen Gilde are happy to take your group to the most beautiful locations in town. Thanks to an extensive cycle network in the Green Heart of Holland there is a lot to discover in and around Gouda. Green Cow Bike Tours offers guided cycle tours. With a cycle route by Gouda Tourist **Information** it is possible to explore the area on a rental bike from **KECK.BIKES**, or on a cool but sustainable E-Chopper from E-Chopper Adventures.




